- John Parker asked if anyone recalled if there were tables at the Thomas Jack park in Dalby or should we take our own to





I, sorry, SHMBO decided that I needed a new project to occupy my time and to get me out of the house and as it happened I managed to acquire a complete donor car which was looking for some much needed love, or in reality, a truckload of cash chucked at it to get it back on the road to make it 'better'. All monetary donations towards Project Noddy will not be tax deductible and will secretly be transferred to my Cayman Island bank account, so feel free to remortgage your home, sell your soul or just send cash at any time.

The car was just a rolling shell which had previously been (more like attempted) in the process of having a Datsun motor and other parts installed by someone who thought that they knew











what they were doing and that chopping out the centre crossmember back to the firewall was the way to go. That coupled with the welding (badly) of some mounts direct to the engine bay floor all needed to be undone.

No sooner after his arrival, all verbal comments about his condition

were ignored and work began with a complete strip out of the non existent interior and a sandblast back to bare metal for the shell with a quick primer for rust prevention.

Not that much thought had gone to the problem of rust prevention previously. Ha! The normal spots at the bottom of the A pillars usually associated with a Morris Minor overall weren't as bad as first thought.

Currently the floors and engine bay are being sorted as these components needed attention and some were bent or had rust in them. Some of these parts are being fabricated from scratch from 18 gauge sheet metal. From a structural point of view, some areas have added swages put in, so that there is a bit more strength and to help with the engine torque stress from the proposed engine change.

Next up is the drivers side which I am planning to start during (or even have it finished in) the following few months.
